[Point Nemo](#) has nothing to do with a landmark for clownfish! It is the scientific term for the “oceanic pole of inaccessibility”, i.e. the place in the ocean that is furthest from land – a location in the South Pacific with no one around within an area of **22 million km²**. “Nemo” means “no one” in Latin. Point Nemo is located over **1,000 miles (1,600km)** equidistantly from the coasts of three islands. The closest inhabited land is about **2,700 km** away. However, the closest people are the astronauts in the [International Space Station](#) orbiting just a short **400 km** above the Earth! Incidentally, Point Nemo is where [space debris](#) goes to “die”. The MIR space station has been resting there since 2001. In the 90s, a mysterious noise was picked up less than **1,250 miles** east of Point Nemo. The sound, dubbed "the Bloop", was louder than a blue whale (**video**).
